Agenda

A Barlett/Kramlick motion was made to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Minutes

A Barlett/Kramlick motion was made to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on March 23, 2026. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Blanchette abstained from voting, as he was absent from last month's meeting.

Operations/Maintenance Report

Drew reviewed the items on his report.

A Kramlick/Barlett motion was made to approve installation of Comcast internet at the Saginaw plant. The motion passed unanimously. There will be no charge for the installation.

A Barlett/Hilliard motion was made to approve installation of Comcast internet at the Mount Wolf plant in the amount of \$4212.44. The motion passed unanimously.

Administration Report

Illegal Connections Inspections – Inspections are underway in Chestnut Valley and Rolling Meadows. Both neighborhoods have been responsive. The final neighborhood will be Orchard View. Staff continues to work with Attorney Ruth to gain compliance with those property owners who have not scheduled initial inspections or follow-up inspections of repairs.

Solicitor's Report

Attorney Silcox reviewed a couple of items on Attorney Ruth's report.

Engineer's Report

Mr. Toms provided status updates on various projects including the Musser Run pump station project, sanitary sewer repairs, and various Mt Wolf Plant repairs and upgrades.

A Barlett/Hilliard motion was made to approve the Contract No. 1 Change Orders General Contractor and for Electrical Contractor for Musser Run Pump Station Improvements. The motion passed unanimously.

Record Club of America – Chris made contact with the owner, who is working to gather quotes from contractors for a grinder pump connection or lining the existing pipe. He has no issue with the Authority plugging the upstream portion of the line at this time.

Treasurer's Report
